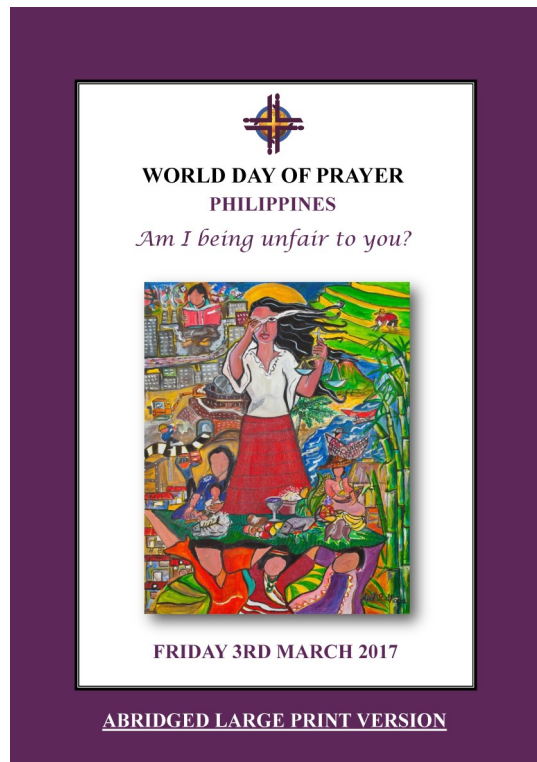

## Building Update

We have had a slight set-back with the builder going into Receivership however we are now working towards contracting a new builder to complete the construction of the new ministry centre. The Director of the Diocesan Property department has responsibility for the building contract, and has been working with the Receivers and QBCC.

Their internal recommendation to the GM of the Diocese, after receiving a report from the Receiver, is to terminate the contract and take back ownership of the site. We are waiting on approval from the GM so that a new tender can be issued as soon as the paper work is completed with the Receiver.
