

Living a Christ worthy life—Matt 10.37-39

In spite of our *unworthiness* Jesus Christ has called us to follow him and become his disciples. As his disciples he now calls to be a *worthy* disciple. To be worthy of him! Here are three examples of what Jesus expects of a worthy disciple:

- They must love him more than father or mother or son or daughter. (Ch10.vs 37)
- They must take up their cross and follow him (Ch10.vs 38)
- They must lose their life (ego) for his sake. (Ch10.vs 39)

Jesus demands the first place in our lives not the left overs. He is right to demand this as he gave us first place in his life. What is the greatest competitor in you life to living the Christ worthy life?

Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or only hear about you in my absence, I will know that you stand firm in the one Spirit, striving together as one for the faith of the gospel. Phil. 1.27


