Building Update

Things are moving ahead slowly due to paperwork required for the builder's Receiver. Last week the Diocese terminated the building contract in accordance with legal advice. On Monday at a meeting with the Diocesan Property department and architect OPUS, it was decided that preparations to issue a new tender can go ahead in parallel with the legal matters. At the Monday 20th Feb meeting it is expected that OPUS will provide a shortlist of 5 or 6 builders and a tender be issued within that week., tenders to close after 3 weeks. The timeline from here on will depend on what approvals will be required from various Diocesan Commissions. Property department is attempting to ensure that this process is streamlined.
