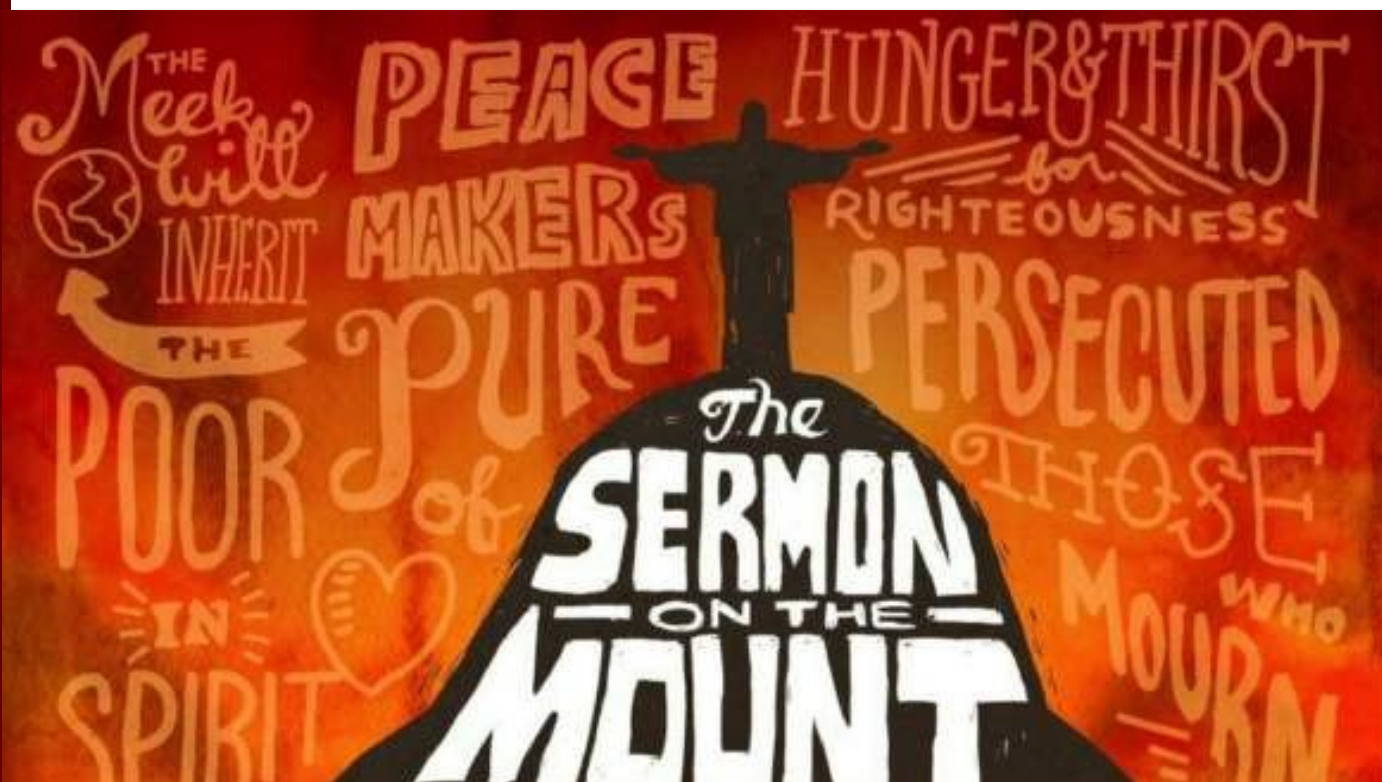


Builders' Notes
