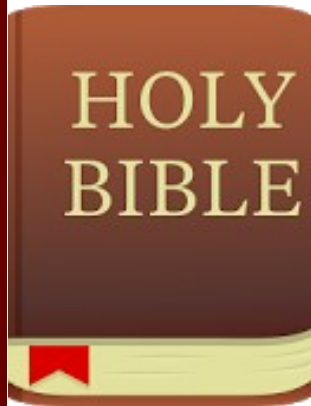

## Mothers Union retiring collection

Mothers Union retiring collection will be on the 26th of March this year. Every year we have two collections one for Anglicare and the other for Overseas aid.
