Mothers Union retiring collection

Mothers Union retiring collection is today! Every year we have two collections one for Anglicare and the other for Overseas aid. Our project overseas this year is for Peace and Reconciliation in Africa, which is the focus of our first collection. The money will be divided between South Sudan, The Democratic Republic of Congo, Uganda and Rwanda to train local woman in furthering themselves in education, health and dealing with domestic violence. This will also aid in the famine in South Sudan.

Building update

The tender period was extended slightly to accommodate builders' request, and our project manager OPUS is now analysing details of the six tenders received. It appears that the new price will be very close to the Diocesan-approved figure under which we commenced the project last year. A tender-evaluation report is expected by mid-week.
